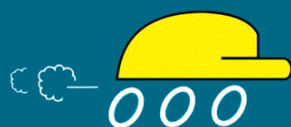

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# Our Visitors Today

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Melksham Town F.C were formed in October 1876; the first game being played at "Challymead". The club were founder members of the Wilts League in 1894 and in 1974 the club joined the Western League. In 1976 Melksham Town were relegated to the newly formed Western League first division.

In 1979 the Town won the First Division title and were duly promoted to the Premier Division where they remained until the end of the 1987/88 season when the Town were relegated back to the First Division.

The club reached a real low point when they finished bottom of the Western League in the 1992/93 season and were relegated from the Western League under the pyramid system to the Wiltshire County League. The clubs stay was a short one as Town clinched the Wiltshire County Championship in 1993/1994 season and with all the necessary work off the field completed gained promotion back to the Great Mills Western League Division 1 after one year.

In 1996/97 the Town clinched the 1st Division title and in the process became the first ever winners under Screwfix Direct, the new sponsors. 1997/98 saw Town finish in 3rd position in The Western League Premier and the season 2001/02 saw the club celebrate its 125th anniversary and finished in 10th position,

The Town continued to ply their trade in the Toolstation Western League Premier Division until the 2009/10 season which saw the club finish 19th and relegated to the First division. The 2011-2012 season saw the club promoted back to the Premier Division after finishing runners up where they remained until gaining promotion at the end of the 2017-2018 season.

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The 2014-2015 season culminated in the club winning the Toolstation Western League Premier Division for the first time in their history but club were denied promotion as the current facility at The Conigre was deemed inadequate and the proposed new ground at The Oakfield's was delayed due in part to issues with "great crested newts"!

The new ground suffered further delays resulting in the club starting the 2016-2017 season with a series of away fixtures before finally being forced to return to The Conigre with the last game played at The Conigre on Boxing Day 2016 with a 1-0 victory over near neighbours Bradford Town.

Finally, the club moved to their £7m facility which was funded by Wiltshire Council, Football Foundation and Premier League facilities fund at The Oakfield's Melksham in January 2017. Although the opening day on 14th January 2017 saw an FA Vase replay defeat to Bristol Manor Farm in front of just over 1,200 people.

The 2016/2017 season saw the club finish in 3rd position in the Western Premier League and win the Les Phillips League Cup for the first time in their history. The 2017-2018 season, the first full season at The Oakfield's, saw the club finish runners up in the Toolstation Western League Premier and gain promotion to Step 4 and the Evostik Southern League representing the highest level in the club's history.

The season also included a FA Vase quarter final tie in front of a record 2,208 spectators at The Oakfield's which saw the Town lose to eventual FA Vase winners Thatcham Town.

# Our Visitors Today

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Under the guidance of Kieran BAGGS, the team quickly established itself in the Southern League during the 2018-2019 season, picking up some notable scalps during the season and continuing to play in front of impressive crowds at the new ground. The team remained around the top half of the table for the entire season amongst experienced Southern League rivals.

In March 2019 Kieran and some of his backroom staff departed Oakfield's, this led to Luke Ballinger and Andy Sandell looking after First Team matters for the rest of the season. This provided an opportunity for several young players to step up from the Under 18 and Reserve Team. A number of these players were able to show immediately the talent and potential to make the step up and have formed part of the new squad for this season.

In May 2019 the new management team of Richard Fey and Nathan Rudge joined Melksham and have spent the summer recruiting a young and ambitious squad.

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## Playing Squad

**Jamie BARTLETT** – Jamie is a familiar face to local football fans having served our near neighbours Bradford Town with distinction over recent years. He joins us in the Southern League bringing a physical presence and outstanding shot stopping ability to our defence.

**Harry PICKERING** – Harry is a young goalkeeper who represented the Melksham Under 18 Team last year as well as playing with the Chippenham Academy. He is talented and has the opportunity to develop his career further with the First Team this year.

**Will CHRISTOPHER** – Will joined the Melksham ranks from Cirencester Town in October 2019. Prior to this Will had played at Swindon Town and Bath City. A capable and poised defender, quick on his feet and experienced at this level despite his young age.

**Josh FORD** – Josh is an experienced Central Defender who began his career at Queens Park Rangers. He is an uncompromising defender who defends with commitment. A natural leader, he was the Captain at Yate Town when they won promotion in 2019 to the Southern Premier League. Josh has also played at Paulton, Frome and Larkhall.

**Dave Thompson** – Dave is one of Melksham's record appearance holders having played over 300 times for the club since making his debut in August 2008. He is a key part of this years defence having re-signed to the club in November 2019. He lists Frome Town, Paulton Rovers and Bradford Town amongst his previous clubs.

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**Leigh BAILEY** – Leigh joined us from Street having also played at Bridport in previous seasons. He is a dominating presence at both ends of the pitch. Capable of playing anywhere he is another experienced player who will make a solid impression at Melksham.

**Joseph ROMANSKI** – Joe has recently joined the club on loan from Swindon Town. Joe is a young defender who has shown outstanding potential already in his early career. Having completed a loan spell at Bath City last year he earned an extension on his contract at Swindon. He is a brave and composed defender who will bring much to our defence.

**Ian JEFFERY** – A welcome return to Melksham for Ian who has been helping Westbury United to Western League success in recent seasons. He is a valuable addition to the team in the defensive unit and has a left foot that can whip crosses in or deliver precision set pieces. A local lad who is popular amongst fans and players. Currently on dual registration with Warminster Town.

**Sayed IBRAHIM** – From his debut in 2011, he has been a loyal and dependable member of the Club. Comfortable anywhere in the back line he has good pace and is aided by dangerous long throws which can effectively become a corner when attacking. Another good role model for the younger lads in the squad.

**Jake HUTCHINGS** – Jake impressed for the Reserves last season and stepped up admirably during the final months showing a maturity and calmness which defied his years. He will aim to gain further Southern League experience this year and look to cement a place in the team. Currently on dual registration with Odd Down.

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**Tom MACK** – Tom is a player who has developed in recent seasons through the Reserve Team. A naturally left footed player who can operate anywhere on the left. He has scored regularly for the Reserves and will look to bring his undoubted talent into the Southern League. A youngster with bags of promise and a cracking attitude. Currently splitting his time between home and Plymouth University.

**Aidan CHAINEY** – Aidan joins us from Street having previously been a product of the Yeovil Town Academy, where he played for their U18s and made a couple of appearances on the bench for the First Team. He has also played for Gillingham and Weymouth. He is a hard-working midfielder who always gives 100%. A decent signing for us who will provide skill and tact in the midfield.

**Will THOMSON** – Will is a local lad who is developing into a quality member of the squad. He shows good composure when on the ball. Will has undoubted talent and will be one to watch this season after an impressive end to last year.

**Liam MONELLE** – Liam is a young player who started his career with Bristol City. He has since had spells at Bath City, Frome Town and Paulton Rovers. He was highly rated at Paulton Rovers during his time there, and was their Supporters Player of the Year last Season. A highly energetic and combative midfielder he joins us from Yate Town.

**Ollie WEBB** – Ollie first played for Melksham in March 2017. He is a strong defensive player comfortable playing anywhere in defence as well as in midfield. He is strong aerially and lists Trowbridge Town, Calne, Odd Down and Westbury United amongst his former clubs.

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**Matt HURLEY** – A composed and skilful midfielder who has already shown in pre-season why he has been recruited. He can pick a pass with ease and has scored the odd wonder goal in previous seasons. Previously played at Bridgwater Town with the Manager and displays an attitude which will help us this season.

**Luke BALLINGER** – Luke has played for several teams in the region having begun with Bristol City before moving onto spells with Frome Town, Gloucester City and Chippenham Town. He can literally play anywhere and will regularly score goals from all over the pitch. He is the record England Futsal Cap holder with over 108 caps.

**Chris ALLEN** – Chris is an experienced ball playing midfielder with the ability to pick a pass and split defences wide open. He has previously played at Swindon Town, Bath City, Weymouth and Chippenham Town. A classy operator who will again provide a good example to those younger members of the squad.

**Albie HOPKINS** – Albie is a recent signing who has Football League pedigree having started his career with Oxford United. He is a lively wide player who can play on either side and has both pace and skill. Most recently with Yate Town he has also played on loan at Oxford City and Rushden & Diamonds.

**Jake MAWFORD** - Jake has joined us on loan from WSM. He is an exciting attacking player who is versatile and has made an immediate impact scoring twice in the victory at Bideford and contributing to an unbeaten December.

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**Jack BALL** – Jack is a summer signing from Paulton Rovers where he has been the top scorer regularly for over the last few seasons. He began his career at Yeovil Town and has since shown himself to be one of the most consistent goal scorers at Southern League level and a constant threat to defences. Jack is well in the hunt for the Golden Boot in the League.

**Phil ORMROD** – Phil is a new signing for Melksham having previously played for Gillingham Town, Dorchester Town and Street. He is a powerful and mobile centre forward who has shown he can score goals at every level he has played at.

**Sol PRYCE** – Sol is a young attacker who joined us from Highworth Town in October 2019. Prior to this he was a Swindon Town player who scored twice on his League debut against Stevenage in late 2018. He also spent time on loan at Dulwich Hamlet and Bath City at the end of the season. Strong on the ball and a natural finisher.

Swans continue to soar with another five star performance

After yet another superb performance by Slimbridge in front of their highest crowd of the season against a good Evesham United side they now sit just a point outside the playoff places and only 2 points from third position. It shows how much the club has achieved this year, as they have now secured more points and having scored one less goal than the whole of last season and we have only just reached the half way point.

Lee Driver-Dickerson and Alex Lumsden were forced into a late re-jiggle of the team that won the last two games with Joel White missing due to family commitments, Dan King injured and late call-offs from Adam Price and Korey Pring. Dion Chambers duly slotted into the back four, Jack Horrell dropping into midfield and Rhys Sarson up front with under-18 starlet Ethan Dunbar taking to the bench.

The game started well for Evesham who had much of the early possession, Paul Sullivan heading a cross from the right straight at Lewis Adams after only 4 minutes. A few minutes later Harry Franklin shot over from a visitor's corner as the home side did well to contain the Robins constant threat.

On 10 minutes a free kick to Evesham was saved by Adams, who cleared the initial danger before Jordon Sangha fired back in to Adams arms.

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The Swans came back into the game with style on 20 minutes taking the lead through Ryan Beckinsale, picking the ball up on the left and letting fly from 25 yards out into the net via the far post. Beckinsale then forced a great save from Jonathan Brown after a good team move from the back.

# Our History

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## **In The Beginning**

The Gloucestershire village of Slimbridge is world renowned for its Bird Sanctuary, but in recent years much hard work has gone into making Slimbridge better known in football circles.

The Club's history can be traced back to the 1899/1900 season playing in local football at various venues in and around the village. A gap in the records suggests there may have been a couple of seasons when no games were played, and thus, officially, the Club's centenary was celebrated in 2002/03.

It was not until 1951 that the current ground at Wisloe Road was acquired, after a former player, Evi Thornhill, bequeathed it to the Club in his Will. For the next forty-odd years the Club were predominantly members of the Stroud and District League with varying degrees of success and failure, except for a period between 1960 and 1968 when they were in the Gloucester Northern Senior League.

## **Point Of Collapse**

By 1988, a point of collapse approached, but fortunately, a handful of committee members led by Gordon King and Gordon Tudor kept the Club afloat. The following season local businessman Paul Chappell arrived. The Club was stabilised and construction of new changing facilities, to County League standard, were completed.

## **Start Of A New Reign**

As playing standards improved, the building of a long awaited Social Club commenced in the 1998/99 season. The following year saw the introduction of John Mack, a successful local entrepreneur, as Chairman. In the summer of 2001, Doug Gray was appointed Manager.

# Our History

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After achieving the Runners-up spot in their first season in the Gloucester County League, the club were accepted into the Hellenic League. Hellenic Division One West was won by an eleven point margin in 2002/03 and with it, promotion to the Hellenic Premier Division, where a creditable fourth place finish was achieved in 2003/04. In a marvelous season the club also claimed the Hellenic 'Norman Matthews' Floodlit Cup and the G.F.A. Challenge Trophy.

## **Arrival Of Floodlights**

The summer of 2003 saw the floodlights installed. A pre-season visit from Conference side Forest Green Rovers on 22nd July, produced a then ground record attendance of 427 to witness the inaugural floodlit game at Wisloe Road.

A few weeks later on Sunday 24th August, that ground record was beaten at a Bank Holiday Hellenic Premier Division fixture that was part of the 2003/04 annual 'Ground Hop' weekend. Local rivals Shortwood United provided the opposition in front of a crowd of 525.

Season 2004/05 again saw a fourth place finish in the Hellenic Premier Division, along with a first entry into the F.A. Vase competition which resulted in a useful run to the third round proper before a 2-1 extra time defeat at 'Screwfix' Western League side Backwell United concluded an enjoyable campaign. Sadly, in the February, Gray stood down after nearly four seasons at the helm of the club.

The club started season 2005/06 under newly appointed Manager Doug Foxwell. A first entry into the F.A. cup saw a visit from Wessex League side Wimborne Town.

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A 1-0 defeat did not dampen the sense of occasion on the first day of the season. A second successful run in the F.A. Vase again came to an end in the Third Round Proper, with a 3-1 defeat at South Midland Premier, Welwyn Garden City. After a record-breaking 64 game season, the team managed a fifth place finish in the Hellenic Premier Division. The club also won the Hellenic 'Norman Matthews' Floodlit Cup and the GFA Challenge Trophy, both for the second time in three seasons.

## **Reserves Make Headway**

After two successive third place finishes in the Stroud and District League First Division, season 2005/06 saw the Reserve side finally win the title and with it, promotion to the Gloucester Northern Senior League Division Two. This was the same League title that the first team won in season 1998/99 which proved the springboard for five successive first team promotions.

## **Rise To New Heights**

Season 2006/07 proved the most successful in the Club's history to date, with both the First Team and Reserve side recording League and Cup doubles, with the added bonus of record-breaking F. A. Cup and Vase runs for the senior side as well.

In the F.A. Cup, a five match run from the Extra-Preliminary Round finished at Merthyr Tydfil in the Third Qualifying Round. Along the way there were memorable wins against two other Southern Premier sides, 2-1 at Yate Town and 3-1 at home to Chippenham Town.

It was six matches in the F.A. Vase before defeat was tasted, the run ending in the Fifth Round Proper at home to the eventual winners, Truro City.

# Our History

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In the Hellenic Premier Division, a solid start was established. Due to the Cup runs, and then bad weather, which led to a record number of postponements during the subsequently extended season, half a seasons fixtures had to be played in the final two months. A tremendous effort saw the Club bring the Championship Shield to Wisloe Road, the winning margin being three points over second placed North Leigh.

There was a rousing performance in the G.F.A. Trophy Final against Almondsbury Town. A 3-1 victory not only retained the Trophy, but recorded a third success in four seasons in that competition.

The Reserve side had an early success in the Gloucester Northern Senior League Cup with a 2-0 win against Division One Tuffley Rovers. This saw confidence rise and they went on to break a Gloucestershire Northern Senior League record in winning Division Two with a Played 30, Won 30 record.

## **Promotion To The Southern League**

Alongside the playing success, progress in the improvement of facilities allowed the First Team to be accepted into the BGB Southern League Division One Midlands for Season 2007/08, the highest level that the Club have ever operated at.

## **Return To A New Beginning**

On July 10th 2007 the club decided not to take up the opportunity of playing in the BGB Southern League Division One Midlands for Season 2007/08, instead the club reverted back to the Gloucester Northern Senior League. This meant a big upheaval in the club both on and off the field with the manager Doug Foxwell and several senior players moving on the pastures new.

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However a loyal band of players stayed on including James Cole taking over as player manager with assistance from long term club captain Leon Sterling.

## **Climb Back Up The Ladder**

Four promotions followed as the club regained their previous status. The reins were handed over to Leon Sterling, who moved into the Manager's role, joined by Assistant and long time Slimbridge stalwart Freddy Ward. The two have guided the side to a very respectable sixth and fifth place in their first two seasons back in the Hellenic Premier.

## **Switching Leagues**

After three top six finishes in the Hellenic Premier League, The Swans applied for a transfer to the Toolstation Western Premier League, a move approved by the FA in the Summer of 2013.

## **Return To The Southern League**

After two seasons in the Toolstation Western Premier League, a third place finish at the end of the 2014/15 season gave the Swans a second opportunity to return to the Southern Football League. This time the club accepted the offer and took their place in the South and West division finishing a credible 18th.

## **Welcome To Thornhill Park**

At the start of the 2016-17 season prior to our annual freindly fixture with neighbours Forest Green Rovers, the football ground in Wisloe Road was renamed in honour of the gift in 1960 from former Chairman Evi Thornhill of the land the club still occupies to this day.

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Evi's son, Tony and his wife Margaret were on hand to cut the ceremonial ribbon, and Tony made a short heartfelt speech about how much the renaming meant to him and the entire Thornhill family, and how honoured they were that the football club had recognised their father in this way.

## **Changes On The Bench**

After a run of poor results the club parted company with manager Leon Sterling in December 2016, his assistant Freddy Ward taking up the post initially on a caretaker basis. Freddy continued in the role for the following season bringing in Lee Driver-Dickerson as his assistant and former Gloucester City player Lee Smith as player coach.

After tough year, just avoiding relegation Freddy Ward stepped down as first team manager at the end of the 2017/18 season. Driver-Dickerson taking up the reigns with Cheltenham youth coach Dave Strain as his assistant.

## **Progression Through Youth**

After three tough years of survival in the Southern League the committee decided to start a new Under 18's team, entering into the Midland Floodlit Youth League, Division 1 for the 2018/19 season. The aim was to produce a new crop of Swans to bolster the first team and provide a platform for local players to progress into Southern League Football

The move was a resounding success, seven of the Under 18 players stepping up to first team football during the season and Lewis Adams taking the number one jersey for the majority of the season.

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## **Another step forward**

At the start of the 2019/20 season the clubs fifth in the Southern League, further progress is being made on the pitch. Alex Lumsden an academy coach at Bristol Rovers and former Swansea player Dion Chambers joining Lee Driver-Dickerson's backroom staff.

The Under 18's have moved across to a new County based youth league and the formation of an Under 17 team to bolster the clubs youthful squad gives an exciting air to the future of the club.
